Prior training required

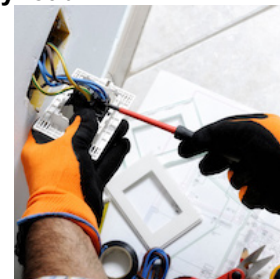
An (electro)technical background at MBO level, or equivalent practical experience, is required.
